

CAA Underwater Acoustics and Signal Processing Student Travel Subsidy Application Form

Purpose: Provide a \$250 or \$500 travel subsidy to students for attending and giving an oral or poster presentation at a national or international conference on underwater acoustics and/or signal processing.

Procedure

- Submit the subsidy application form, abstract of the paper, and a letter of support from your university supervisor. Mail to the award coordinator, Dr. D.C. Stredulinsky, 32 John Cross Drive, Dartmouth, NS, B2W 1X3. All items must be received by the award coordinator, on or before September 30, or on or before March 31, and apply to conferences within the 6 months following the deadline date.
- There are a limited number of awards given on a first-come first served basis. You will be notified within 15 days after the deadline date if your application is successful or not, and if so, notified of the value of your Travel Subsidy (\$250 or \$500).
- After the conference complete and submit the 'Proof of Oral Presentation' form to the CAA treasurer. The subsidy cheque will be mailed to you within 30 days of receipt of the completed form.

Eligibility Requirements:

In order to be eligible for the Travel Subsidy you must meet the following requirements:

1. Full-time student at a University. NOTE: Priority will be given to students at a Canadian University.
2. Student Member in good standing of the Canadian Acoustical Association.
3. Distance traveled to the conference must exceed 150 km (one way).
4. Give an oral or poster presentation at the conference on the subject of underwater acoustics and/or signal processing. Due to limited funding, a travel subsidy can only be given to the presenter of the paper even though there may be more than one student authors.

The author is welcomed and encouraged to submit a summary paper for publication in the Canadian Acoustics journal but this is not mandatory.
